



PERMIT APPLICATION FOR WORK IN THE PUBLIC WAY

- A. No one may make an excavation or installation in the public way (street, sidewalk or lot line) without first obtaining a permit authorizing the work.
- B. Restoration of any paved area within the public way requires an additional permit authorizing the work, or a deposit to cover the cost of surface restoration by City forces.
- C. Restoration of concrete paved areas in the public way may be done only by DPW licensed concrete contractors.
- D. If a company other than the excavation permittee is to do the concrete restoration work, that company must take out the appropriate permit.
- E. Connections to the sewer mains require a fee per connection.
